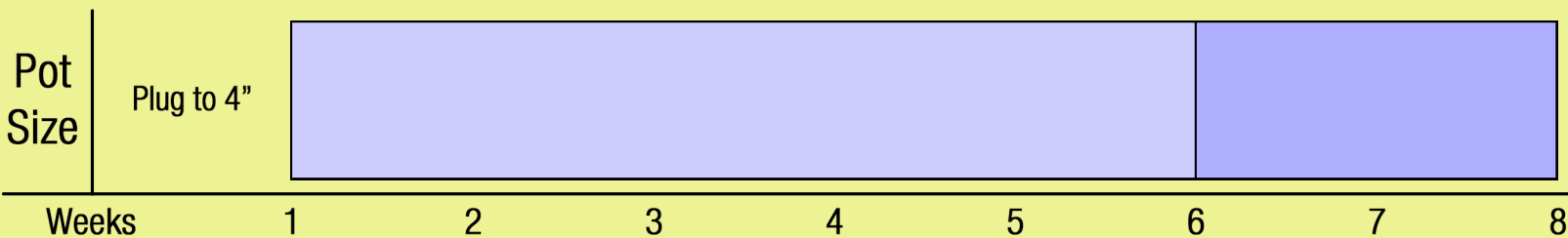


Growing Recipe

pH: 5.6 - 6.8

Fertilization Recommendations: 100 - 150 PPM

EC: 1.0 - 1.5

Light Levels: Part shade

Water Requirements: Moist to slightly dry between waterings

Hardiness Zones: 5 - 8

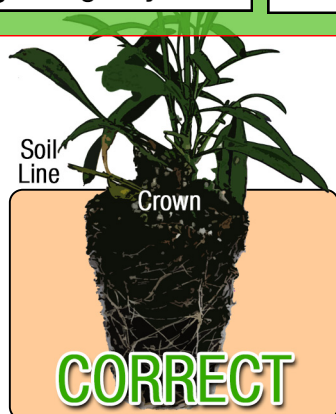
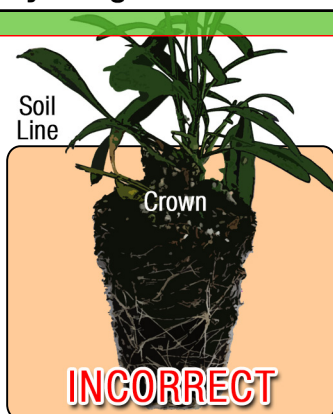
Possible Problems: Insect: Aphids, snails, & slugs are possible
Diseases: Root rot, if they don't have good drainage

Habit: Vigorous groundcover

Day Length for Flowering: Long Day

Description

This slow spreading ground cover is a wonderful addition to the lightly shaded garden. Excellent at container's edge and is a great long-lived mixer in a pot. Its bright white edge and stripes on short leaves contrast well with ferns, Hosta and Bacopa. Late to emerge in spring. Compared to its cousin 'Island Brocade', it has white variegation rather than yellow.
