

Local lettuce, year-round
Soilless hydroponic gardening is all the rage for three simple reasons: It saves land, water, and time. "Lettuce matures three times faster with hydroponics, and we use a tenth of the water of traditional farming," explains Coby Gould of Denver's GrowHaus. This also means Denver now has a constant supply of local, fresh, organic greens, like Bibb lettuce (at Denver-area Whole Foods Markets) and bok choy, basil, and other leafy greens (at the city's Marczyk Fine Foods).
