New for 2008, 'Aurora White' features dense flowers on strong stems. It reaches about 3 feet tall in

the garden. Warm temperatures and long day conditions induce flowering. Plug finish time is five to six weeks. Flowering stems will start to elongate two to three weeks after transplanting. Ajuga

'Toffee Chip', a variegated sport of 'Chocolate Chip', is a small-leafed and vigorous ground-

cover. Mature leaves feature creamy gold margins around shades of gray-green in the center. New leaves display brown and tan shades. Blue flowers emerge from 5-inch spikes. Hardy to Zones 5–9, this variety tolerates sun with little to no burn. Terra Nova Nurseries. www.terranova nurseries.com (800) 215-9450.

Bacopa

'Scopia Great Pink Ring' is one of the new additions to the Scopia series. Hardy to Zones 9–11, rooting takes 14 to 18 days at temperatures of 64–75° F. Use a well-drained potting mix. Keep pH level at 5.5–6.5

Hibiscus

'Pink Elephant' is a hardy perennial featuring bright-pink flowers that measure up to 1 foot across. It measures 5-6 feet tall and works well in the landscape or mixed within a perennial border. Hardy to Zone
