
## Growing Recipe ARUM WHITE WINTER



## **Description**

Extremely good markings of bright white on its leaves. The leaves are also narrower and more sculptured than other varieties. The leaves appear in fall until early summer then go dormant leaving orange berries for summer color. The foliage pattern is not fully visible until it reaches maturity in its second year.
