
## **Growing Recipe**

## EUPHORBIA 'ROYAL VELVET'



**pH:** 6.5 - 7.5

Fertilization Recommendations: 50 PPM

**EC:** 0.7 - 1.0

Light Levels: Sun

Water Requirements: Dry completely between waterings

Hardiness Zones: 7 - 10

Possible Problems: Insect: Mites and root rots can be an issue

Diseases: Root rot can be an issue

Habit: Clumping

Day Length for Flowering: Day neutral

Tailored evergreen velveteen leaves of rich deep red provide the perfect foil for its spring floral display. In spring, its 8"chartreuse-colored flower spikes have dramatic dark maroon eyes. This cross between E. characias 'Portuguese Velvet' and E. x martinii 'Red Martin' has the best of both worlds! Requires good drainage.
