

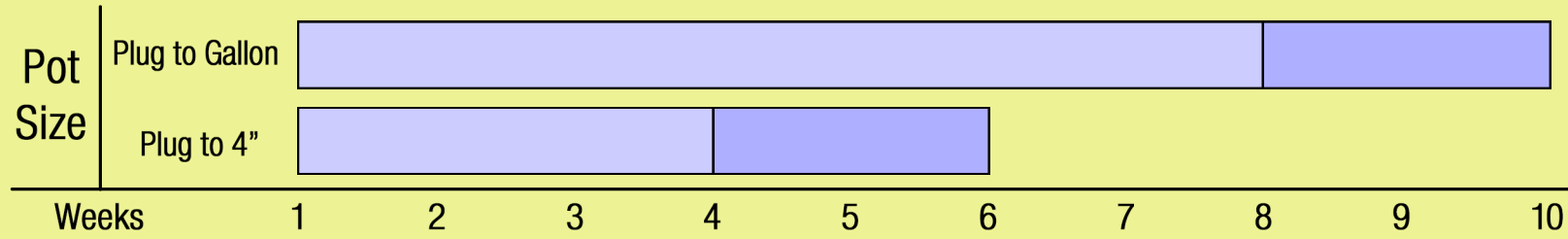


Growing Recipe

HEUCHERELLA 'HARVEST OAK'

Approximate Finish Time From Liner

 = Minimum  = Maximum



pH: 5.5 - 6.5

Fertilization Recommendations: 100 - 150 PPM

EC: 0.6 - 0.9

Light Levels: Sun to shade

Water Requirements: Dry moderately between waterings

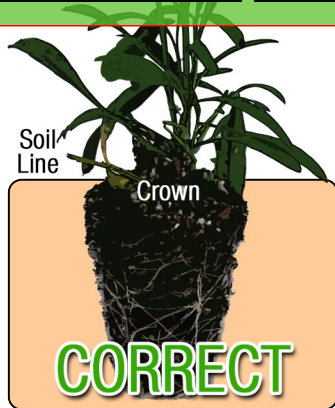
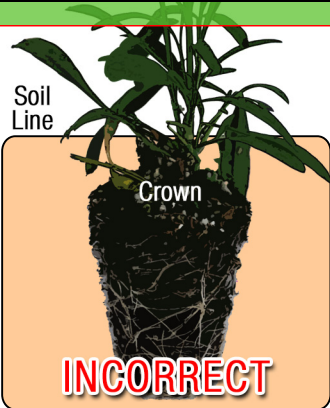
Hardiness Zones: 4 - 9

Possible Problems: Insect: Foliar nematodes may be a problem for gardens in susceptible areas and watch for root weevils.

Habit: Low mound

Diseases: Root rot may occur with excessive soil moisture or poor drainage. **Note**: All Heucherella are rust resistant.

Day Length for Flowering: Day Neutral

Description

This lovely clumping Heucherella has autumn colored leaves of amber and gold. The leaves are palmately cute and fingered. Showy white flowers on short, upright, dark stems provide additional enjoyment over a long season.
