
Growing Recipe

pH: 5.5 - 6.8

Fertilization Recommendations: 150 - 200 PPM

EC: 0.6 - 0.9

Light Levels: Shade to part shade

Water Requirements: Dry slightly between waterings

Hardiness Zones: 4 - 9

Possible Problems: Insect: Thrips, aphids, slugs and snails are all

possible

Habit: Clumping

Diseases: Petiole rot, HVX possible

Day Length for Flowering: Day neutral
