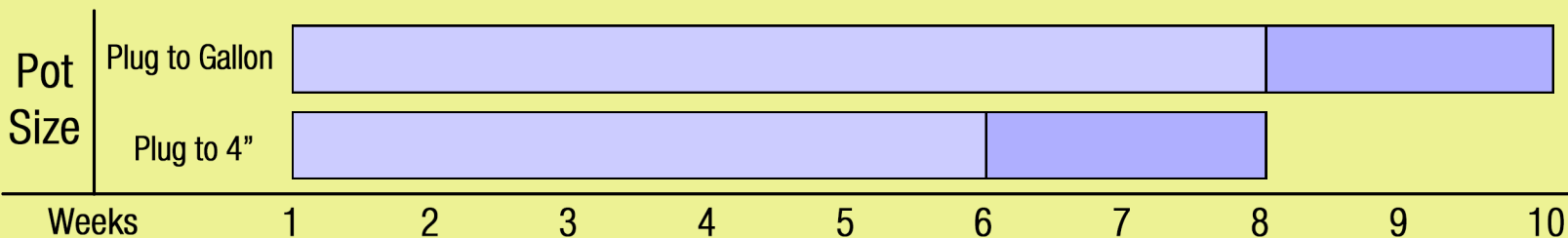


Growing Recipe

pH: 6.5 - 7.0

Fertilization Recommendations: 150 - 200 PPM

EC: 1.0 - 1.5

Light Levels: Full sun to part shade

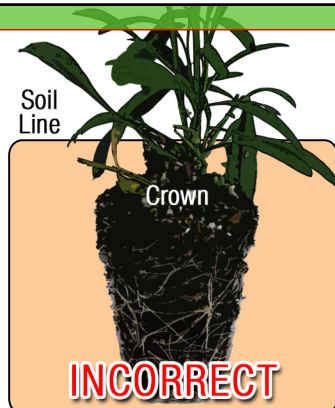
Water Requirements: Dry slightly between waterings

Hardiness Zones: 7 - 11

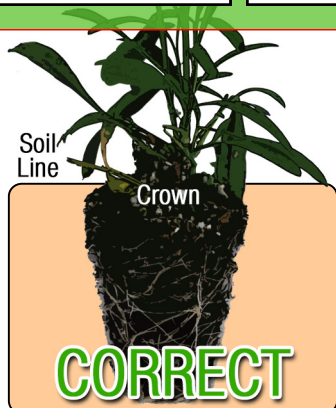
Possible Problems: Insect: No major pests
Diseases: No major diseases if grown with good drainage and high light
