
Growing Recipe PULMONARIA 'REGINALD KAYE'



pH: 5.6 - 6.8

Fertilization Recommendations: 150 - 200 PPM

EC: 1.0 - 2.0

Light Levels: Full sun to part shade

Water Requirements: Dry moderately between waterings

Hardiness Zones: 4 - 9

Possible Problems: Insect: Aphids, slugs are possible

Habit: Clumping

<u>Diseases:</u> Botrytis can be a problem if the

foliage is kept too moist. Leaf spot.

Day Length for Flowering: Day neutral
