



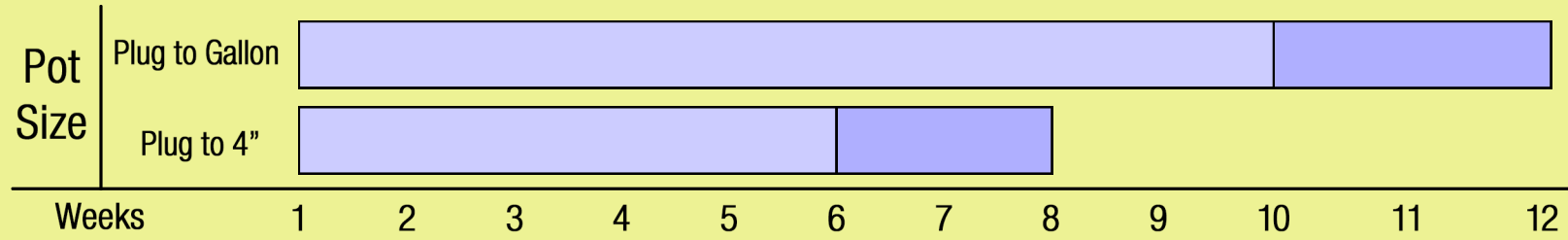

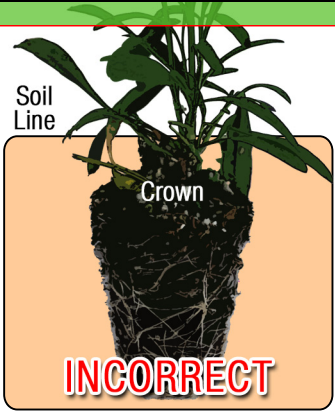
pH: 5.8 - 6.8 Fertilization Recommendations: 150 - 200 PPM EC: 0.75 - 1.5

Light Levels: Part shade to full shade Water Requirements: Keep evenly moist in growing season

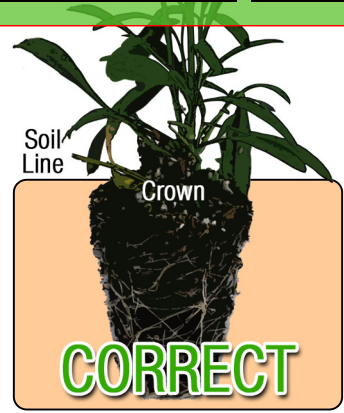
Hardiness Zones: 5 - 9 Possible Problems: Insect: Aphids, mites, white fly are possible

Lavender flowers in airy puffs float over the foliage and add a lovely contrast to this most interesting plant. As the foliage matures more colors are layered upon the leaves. Tones of olive and copper take over from the original bright colors to form a mellow palette. Charming to tuck into a shaded bed or rock garden.
